Implementation of Digital Processes

Research Analysis

SB 1888 directs the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to promulgate rules and procedures to make its construction contracting process paperless, including contracts available in electronic form and the ability to accept digital signatures. The measure also directs ODOT to promulgate rules and procedures for all engineered construction plans to be available in electronic three-dimensional format, and to provide a digital inspection process for construction projects.
