**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC) anticipates a loss of \$122 per non-resident-landowner license, sold. Additionally, based on the current number of resident combination licenses sold in FY18, the agency anticipates a possible annual loss in sales of \$74,540.

- FY18 = 14,908 people x \$5 = \$74,500

Agency records show sales of \$4.1 million worth of nonresident hunting and fishing licenses in FY18.

- The current price for nonresident hunting and fishing licenses is \$197
- The proposed new price is \$75
- The agency is unable to provide the total anticipated negative fiscal impact to the measure because records do not currently track data for license holders that are also landowners.
