SJR 31 directs the Secretary of State to refer to a vote of the people whether or not the Legislature should call a Constitutional Convention to propose revisions or amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution or to propose a new Constitution.

Fiscal Analysis

The resolution provides for a vote of the people regarding the calling of constitutional convention. Article XXIV, Section 2 of the Oklahoma Constitution directs that the question be put before voters at least once every twenty (20) years.

No measureable cost is associated with adding the question to the ballot except for potential incidental ballot printing costs, should they be required. Should the people call for convention, it is reasonable that certain, as yet unspecified, costs would likely be incurred.
