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Floor Substitute (FS)

The FS for HB 1316 requires persons receiving emergency teacher certification to complete at least one day of professional development training prior to entering the classroom. If a person is already in the classroom, the school district must provide six hours of professional development training within two weeks of the person entering the classroom. Training shall be offered by the employing district and must address classroom management skills as well as school and classroom procedures and policies. School districts are also required to provide additional training for emergency-certified teachers. The school principal is required to provide a mentor for an emergency-certified teacher, in addition to an instructional coach that may be provided.

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
