**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for HB 2037 authorizes county sheriffs hosting services of end users that allows for a connection to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (OLETS) to assess and collect fees for the itemized actual costs of providing various services and goods related to OLETS. Sheriffs must provide the terms and itemized costs in an inter-local agreement to all affected parties and file the agreement with the office of the county clerk and in the offices of each governmental entity involved. Revenue generated from the fees shall be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee Account for use as outlined in the measure.

The CS to HB2037 provides that if a county offers hosting services to OLETS, the sheriff may assess and collect fees for the itemized actual costs of providing personnel, reoccurring user fees, necessary hardware and accessories, installation of equipment, maintenance, training and operational expenses for the utilization of the hosting data system and shall provide the terms and itemized costs in an inter-local agreement between both parties which shall be filed with the county clerk and offices of each agency involved. The fees collections shall be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee Account.
