Bill Analysis

HB 2882 transfers oversight responsibility of the 9-1-1 program from the Department of Public Safety to the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority. The measure directs the Authority to develop training standards relating to evidence-based programs for instruction programs recognizing the need for and delivery of High-Quality Telecommunicator Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (TCPR) that can be delivered by 9-1-1 call takers for acute events requiring Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). The training standards must be developed no later than June 30, 2021.
