Bill Analysis

HB 3400 requires public high schools to offer at least 4 advanced placement courses available to students beginning with the 2024- 2025 school year. Local boards of education in each district are responsible for ensuring that all high school students have access to advanced placement courses. The Statewide Virtual Charter School Board must maintain an online learning platform to provide online learning opportunities for Oklahoma students that are aligned with subject matter standards. The State Department of Education is directed to provide information to all local boards of education, to be distributed to students and parents, on available opportunities and the advanced placement enrollment process.
