Bill Analysis

HB 3877 provides that the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners and the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision shall have exclusive power and authority to determine the qualifications and fitness of all applicants for admission to practice osteopathic medicine and all professions under the Board's authority respectively in Oklahoma and further requires all applicants to submit to a national criminal history check.
