**Bill Analysis**

HB 4058 modifies the appointing authority for the five members of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission. The measure provides for the Governor to appoint 3 members, President Pro Tempore to appoint 1 member, and Speaker of the House to appoint 1 member. Each member would serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority. The measure also grants the Governor appointing authority over the Executive Director of the Commission with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Executive Director shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor, but may be removed from office by a two-thirds vote of each chamber of the Legislature. The measure also repeals language outlining the qualifications for members of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission.
