**Bill Analysis**

SB 1264 prohibits any political subdivision from establishing any plan that evaluates or disciplines peace officers based on the officer's issuance of a predetermined or specified number of any type or combination of types of traffic citations or according to the amount of money a judge may collect from persons convicted of a traffic offense. Officials who violate the provisions of the measure may be removed from office in the case of elected officials or removed from his or her position in the case of nonelected officials.
