Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 1298 directs the Department of Corrections to create a certificate of rehabilitation that will certify what reentry programs that the offender has completed while incarcerated. The measure states that the certificate may include social and behavioral programs, substance abuse counseling, mentoring programs, financial planning, physical and mental health programs, and housing and federal assistance programs in addition to educational and vocational programs.

Subject to the availability of funds, requires DOC to develop and implement a comprehensive reentry program with educational, vocational, behavior, substance abuse counseling, mentoring, financial planning, physical/mental health, housing, and federal assistance programs.
