Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 1674 creates a felony offense for persons convicted for purchasing or selling methamphetamine, heroin, cocaine, or fentanyl, in, on or within 1,000 feet of a public or private elementary school, or institution of higher learning or involving a child under 12 years of age. Such persons are subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 5 years. Persons under the age of 18 or enrolled as a full-time student at a public or private secondary school are exempted from the felony charge. Persons stopped in the course of routine traffic stops are also exempted from the provisions of the measure.
