**Bill Analysis**

SB 300 amends the Oklahoma Discovery Code to impose a limit of thirty requests to produce, permit inspection of, or copy documents requested in discovery. Counsels are directed by the measure to come to a written agreement as to a reasonable number of additional requests if the number of requests exceeds thirty. Failure to arrive at a written agreement will require the requestor to file a motion with the court showing that there were good faith attempts to arrive at an agreement and showing good cause for additional document requests.
