Bill Analysis

SB 771 removes a sponsorship path for charter schools. The measure repeals language allowing the State Board of Education to sponsor a charter school if the school's sponsorship was first denied by a school district beginning July 1, 2020. Charter schools sponsored by the State Board may seek an alternative sponsor before July 1, 2020. Schools that fail to find a sponsor by July 1, 2020, shall be dissolved. This measure does not apply to schools affiliated with the Office of Juvenile Affairs or to an entity contracted with the Office.
