Bill Analysis

SB 96 creates a new felony for maliciously inciting or producing imminent violence, injury or death, directed against a law enforcement officer, correctional officer or corrections employee while the officer or employee is in the performance of official duties and because of that person's employment as a law enforcement officer, correctional officer or corrections employee. Any person convicted on these charges will be subject to not less than life imprisonment without parole or the death penalty.
