**Fiscal Analysis**

FY'20 Impact: \$600.00-\$2,000.00 per day of training and the cost of training materials.

Full Year Impact: \$600.00-\$2,000.00 per day of training and the cost of training materials.

This bill requires emergency certified teachers who do not already hold a standard certificate to complete 2 days of minimum professional development training.

School districts may also require this training for newly certified teacher prior to entering the classroom. The measure also requires districts to provide additional training for emergency certified teachers and arrange for mentors to provide support, guidance and advice to the emergency certified teachers.

Districts may incur costs for the training but it will vary and depend on the method they choose to offer the training. Training costs may include consultant fees, materials and resources, and cost of additional training to be offered during the year.
